Reflecting on the first quarter of 2024, we are really proud of what we have achieved!

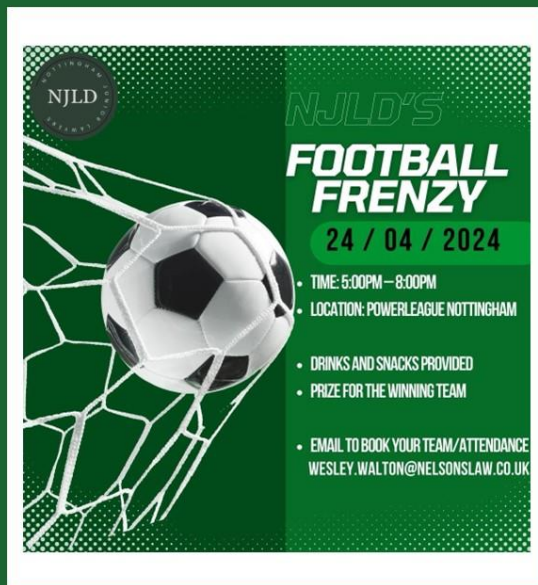
The NJLD committee have worked hard to put some great events on, and to get things in motion for a great 2024.
