



## HAMMOND CUP 2025

Round 1 of the 57<sup>th</sup> annual Hammond Cup will take place on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025 at the Nottingham Law School, with the final being held on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025.

The competition is open to students (including LPC, SQE and bar training course) and those still engaged in professional training in the workplace (including trainee solicitors and those doing SRA SQE, solicitors and paralegal apprentices, pupil barristers (first seat only), paralegals (with up to 2 years' experience) who work and/or study in Nottinghamshire. The Hammond Cup provides competitors an opportunity to practice their advocacy skills in a realistic court room setting, with feedback from experienced practitioners and professional judges.

In round one, candidates will have the choice of whether to present a ten minute:

- criminal sentencing exercise; or
- civil application

The judges will be looking for candidates who show clarity of expression, thoroughness and, of course, persuasiveness. The four candidates with the highest score will be invited to participate in the final in the week commencing 28<sup>th</sup> April, provisionally on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025. A distinguished panel of judges from the Court Circuit will score the candidates and decide on the winner of the Hammond Cup 2025. Prizes will be presented at the Nottinghamshire Law Society AGM on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
