It's time to show off your skills and bring your A-game!



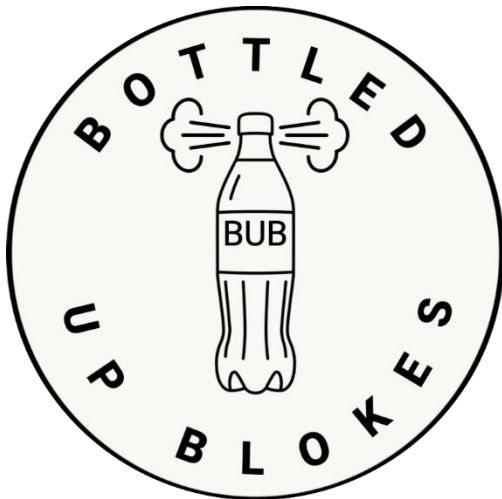
